Expect delays on Orange Avenue between Cecilville Avenue and La Crescenta Avenue due to the water main replacement project.

INTERMITTENT STREET CLOSURE STARTS AUGUST 21, 2023.

The Orange Avenue and La Crescenta Avenue intersection, near Monte Vista Elementary School and Rosemont Middle School will be intermittently closed due to the water main replacement project. The construction zone and temporary street closure will begin on Monday August 21, 2023** and will continue until complete or Tuesday, September 12, 2023*, whichever comes first.

Delays are expected during work hours only. The street will reopen after each work day and on weekends. The detour will be in effect from 7:00 a.m. through 5:30 p.m. daily, Monday through Friday .

Project Facts

- The original project start date of February 2023 was moved to June 12, 2023 to avoid impacting the school drop off and pickup zones.
- To-date approximately 900 linear feet of 12-inch water main have been installed.
- The project consist of replacing a total of 1,700 linear feet of 12 -inch water main on Orange Ave and 600 linear feet of 6inch water main on El Adobe Ln.
- A total of five hydrants will be upgraded.
- Project completion is anticipated this Fall 2023.
