Subject: **Notice of Construction** – Construction of a new 8-inch Water Main on the 4700-4800 blocks of Cheryl Ave. and the 3200 block of Alabama Street, Project E-1034

Dear Resident:

Crescenta Valley Water District (CVWD) has awarded a construction contract to Brkich Construction of Monrovia, to replace the existing old water mains with a new 8-inch diameter water main on the 4700-4800 blocks of Cheryl Ave. and the 3200 blocks of Alabama Street. This is part of CVWD's ongoing pipeline upgrade program (see project location map on reverse side).

Construction is anticipated to begin on Monday April 11, 2022. The contractor will begin construction on Maryland Ave. at Alabama St. and then proceed easterly on Alabama St. towards Pennsylvania Avenue. Please visit CVWD's website at www.cvwd.com for updates on the construction schedule. We anticipate the entire pipeline replacement project to be completed by the end of July 2022.

Please note that there will be a period of time, usually between 6 to 8 hours, when the water service to your home will be shut down. This will occur when the contractor ties the new water main into the existing water main. CVWD will notify each resident, a minimum of 48 hours before the actual shutdown, with a letter and a door hanger that indicates the date and time.

We would like to remind you that the contractor will be installing temporary parking and traffic restrictions along Cheryl Ave., Maryland Avenue, Alabama Street, and Pennsylvania Avenue. This will allow the contractor's crews to work in a safe and expeditious manner to complete the project. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted a minimum of two (2) days before construction. We request that you observe these signs and any other traffic control. Driveways within the construction zone may be temporarily restricted due to the construction. CVWD's on-site inspector and the contractor will assist you with access into and out of your driveway.

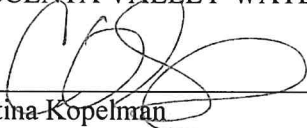

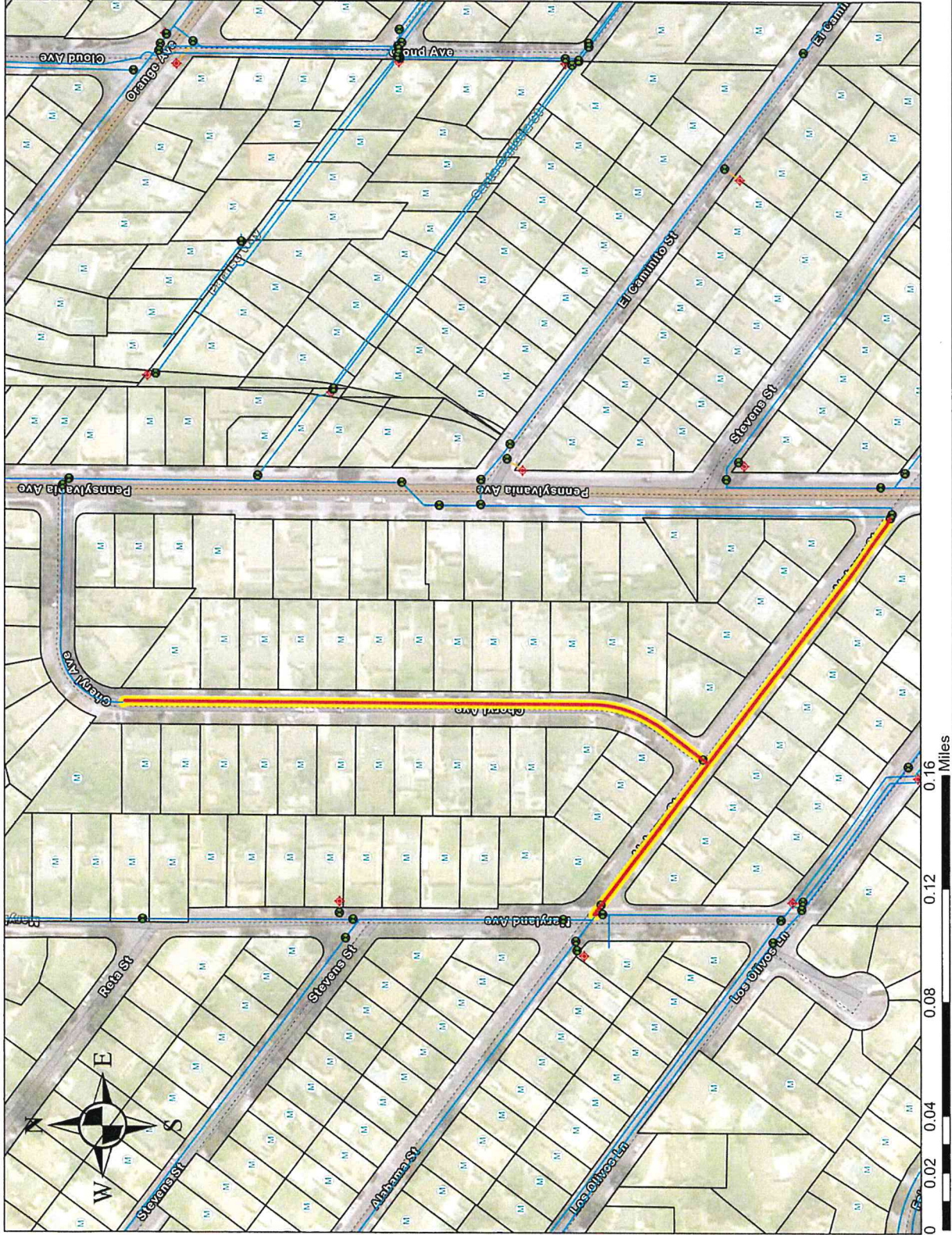

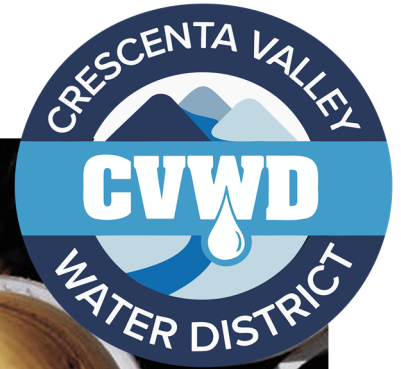
