As part of CVWD's ongoing reservoir maintenance program, the Goss Canyon No. 1 water storage tank is being rehabilitated after having provided decades of service. The improvements to the 420,000-gallon steel water storage tank are necessary to extend its operating life as a source of drinking water, ensure the structural integrity of the reservoir and increase its durability for years to come.

The Contractor, J. Colon Coatings, Inc. began construction in January 2023 when the 420,000-gallon storage tank was taken out of service while welding and other internal and external steel components of the structure were repaired. As of today, most structural repairs have been completed. A new phase of the project which consists of interior roof and shell coating will begin next week. Due to unseasonably cold temperatures and high moisture this winter, a dehumidifier will be necessary to help achieve ideal curing conditions for the coating phase of this project. In the next coming weeks, the dehumidification equipment will run twenty-four (24) hours a day for 2 weeks.

Work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Dehumidification equipment will run for twenty-four (24) hours for the next two weeks or until coating is complete.
