Subject: **Notice of Construction** – 8-inch and 12-inch Water Main Replacement on the 3000-3100 Blocks of Montrose Ave. Project E-1067.

Dear Resident:

Crescenta Valley Water District (CVWD) has awarded a construction contract to Toro Enterprises, Inc., to construct 1,650 LF of new 8-inch and 12-inch water main on the 3000-3100 blocks of Montrose. This is part of CVWD's ongoing pipeline replacement program (see project location map on reverse side).

Construction is anticipated to begin the week of November 13, 2023. The contractor will begin replacing the old 10-inch diameter water mains on the 3000-3100 blocks of Montrose Ave. These water mains were installed in 1961 and will be replaced with new 12-inch diameter water mains. Please visit CVWD's website at www.cvwd.com for updates on the construction schedule. We anticipate the entire pipeline replacement project to be completed by the end of March 2024.

Please note that there will be a period of time, usually between 4 to 6 hours, when the water service to your home will be shut off. This will occur when the contractor ties the new water main into the existing water main. CVWD will notify each resident a minimum of 48 hours before the actual shutdown, with a letter that indicates the date and time. Please sign up for Everbridge notifications on our website for the most up-to-date shutdown information.

The contractor will be installing temporary parking and traffic restrictions along Montrose Ave. This will allow the contractor's crews to work in a safe and expeditious manner to complete the project. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted a minimum of two (2) days before construction. We request that you observe these signs and any other traffic control. Driveways within the construction zone may be temporarily restricted due to the construction. CVWD's on-site inspector and the contractor will assist you with access into and out of your driveway.

As in most construction projects, the work will create a certain amount of unavoidable public inconvenience. Your cooperation in making this project successful will be greatly appreciated.
