Pump Replacement and Casing Rehabilitation of Wells 1 & 7, Project E-999

This update provides information on CVWD's well rehabilitation project that will be taking place on the 3200 and 3300 blocks of Mills Avenue. Below you'll find useful information and a construction schedule for this project.

In recent months, Crescenta Valley Water District (CVWD) has been soliciting bids for the rehabilitation of two of our groundwater production wells. CVWD awarded a contract to General Pump Company (GPC) of San Dimas to perform the well rehabilitation work in the coming months.

These water wells, which were installed in 1940s, are an important component of the water supply in your area and are part of the District's continuing efforts to provide its residents with a safe and reliable water supply.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE (As of December 20, 2018):

March 25, 2018 – April 9, 2019, – Rehabilitation of Well 1, 3246 Mills Ave., Glendale CA, 91214

April 9, 2019 – April 23, 2019 – Rehabilitation of Well 7, 3317 Mills Ave., Glendale CA, 91214

April 24, 2019 – May 1, 2019 – Water Quality Testing

May 3, 2019 – Estimated End of Construction

Residents will have access to their properties at all times. CVWD advises that residents avoid traveling through the construction zone whenever possible. CVWD will provide an updated construction schedule via CVWD's website (www.cvwd.com) to better inform residents of construction activities as the project progresses.

As in most construction projects, this work will create a certain amount of unavoidable public inconvenience.

Reminders:

- Construction will generate noise throughout the project. We apologize in advance for the unavoidable noise as the contractor works on rehabilitating the wells. Heavy crane equipment will be required throughout the project to perform well casing brushing and advanced rehabilitation procedures.
- Most construction is between the hours of 7:30am to 4:00pm weekdays. A notice will be sent to residents in advance to inform residents of any change in construction hours. Our construction crew will do their best to minimize disruption outside of these hours.
