The cost of the rain barrel is \$65 but partial and full amount rebates are available.*

Contact-less delivery is included with order, residents do not need to be present when rain barrel is delivered.

*Residents receive a rebate for the full price of the rain barrel making them FREE after application. All other cities/water agencies give a \$55.00 rebate per barrel. The maximum quantity is 2 rain barrel rebates per household. Visit SoCalWaterSmart.com to apply for a rebate.
