

Questions during the April 4, 2023 6:00 p.m. Townhall Meeting

1. Were we not told when they raised our rates by 7, 7, 7, 6 % for the next 4 years, were we not told by CV water that part of that reason was for infrastructure?
2. And to follow up, have we also not received an abundance of water this year that would save CV water tons of money that wouldn't need to import as much water because of the rainfall, I mean this is a record year like no other. They are saying that it is unprecedented that we haven't had this much rain and hopefully CV has captured a lot of this water and hopefully they will have extra reserves to put towards infrastructure.
3. Are the annual charges on our property tax Bill in perpetuity, or will this just be for a set period of time?
4. This is not a change to the bill that you get every month through the water district, but your property tax bill?
5. Do you anticipate the need to provide additional water treatment to meet the new water standards that will be implemented to address issues such as waste generally classified as forever? Chemicals?
6. As part of the long-term infrastructure, why not drill more production wells versus buying water. Then you'd only pay for treatment and well pumping. Also, what are you doing to increase storage, such as building another water tank, so trying to get at, are there some other cost savings that the district can find?
