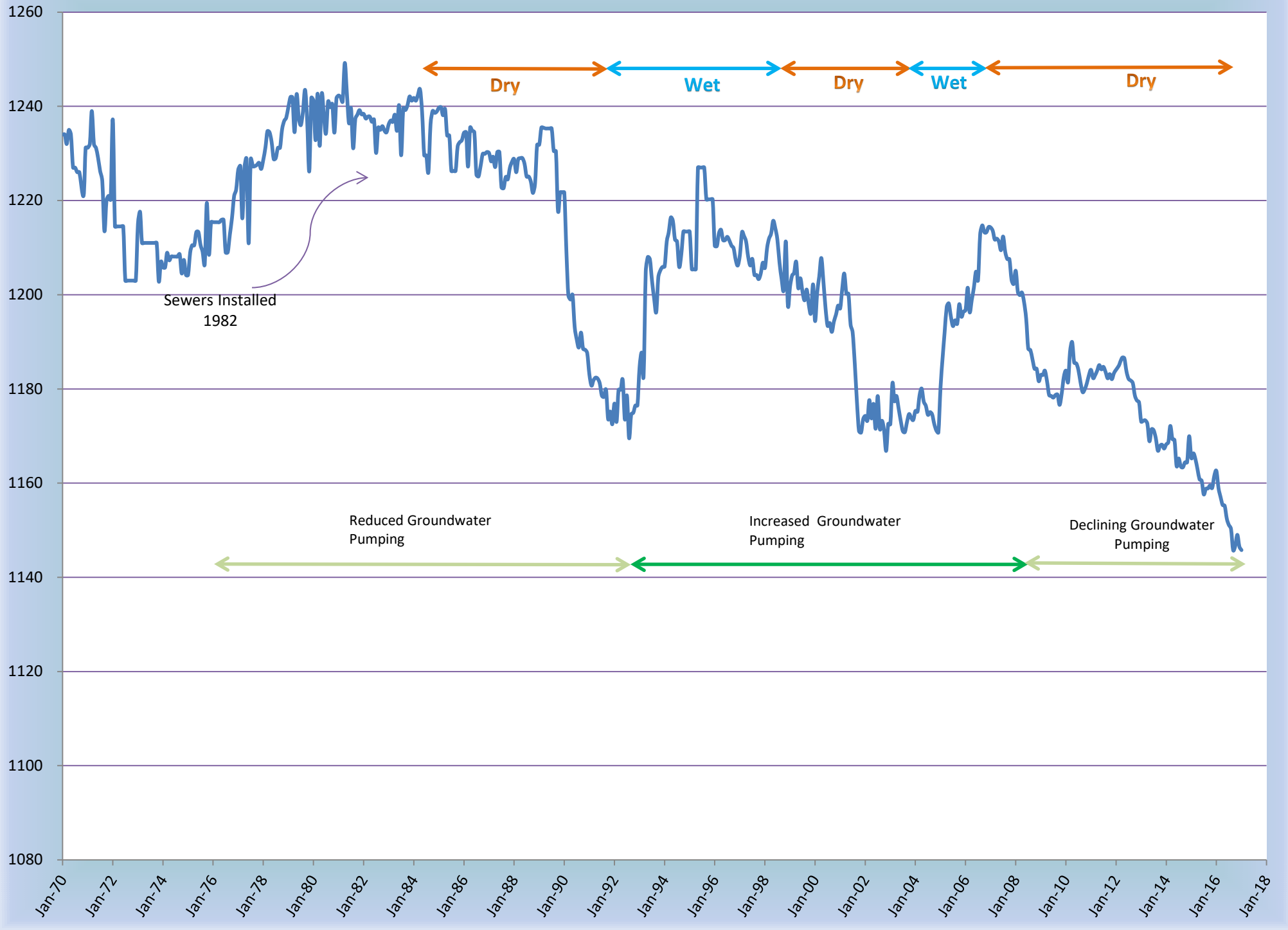
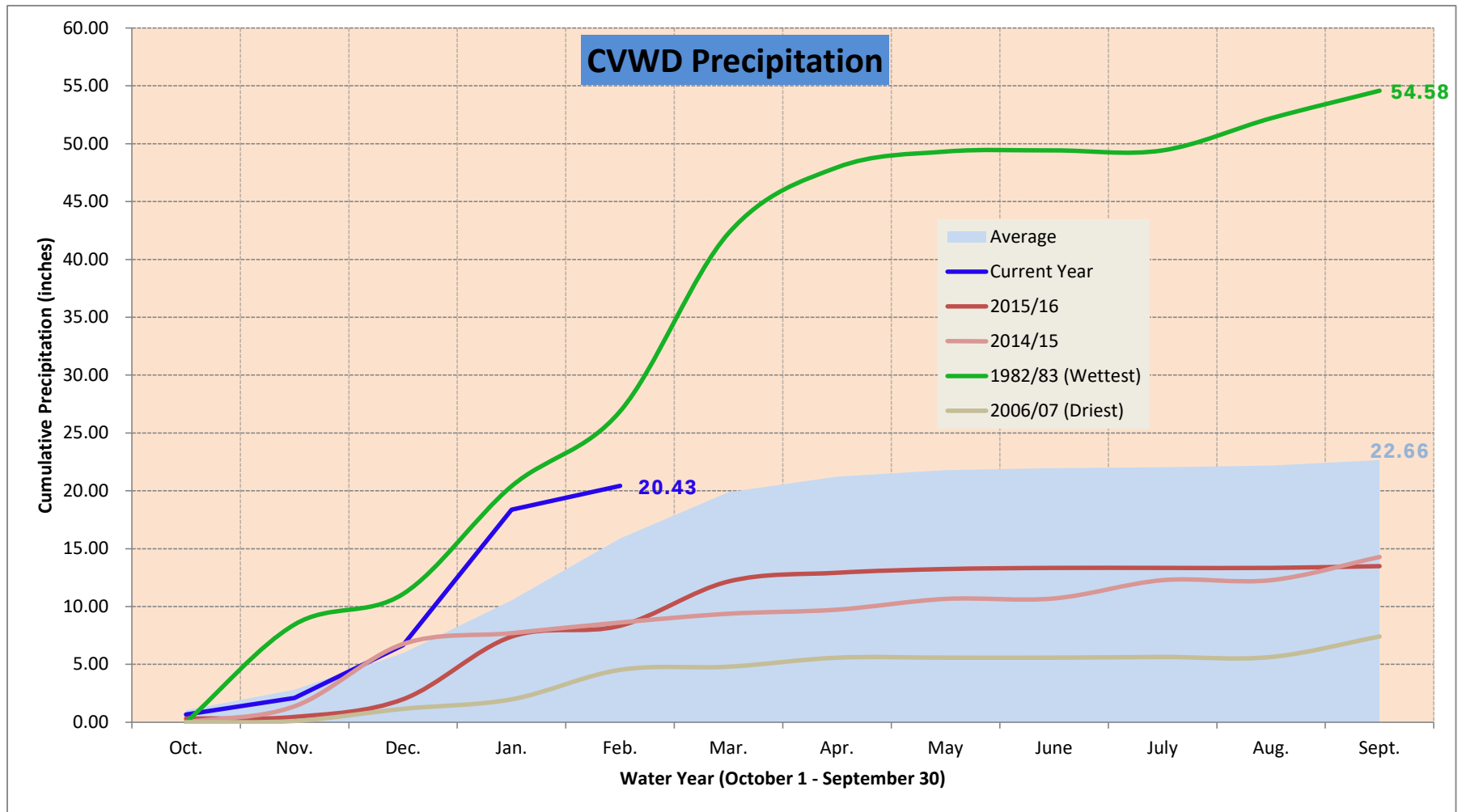


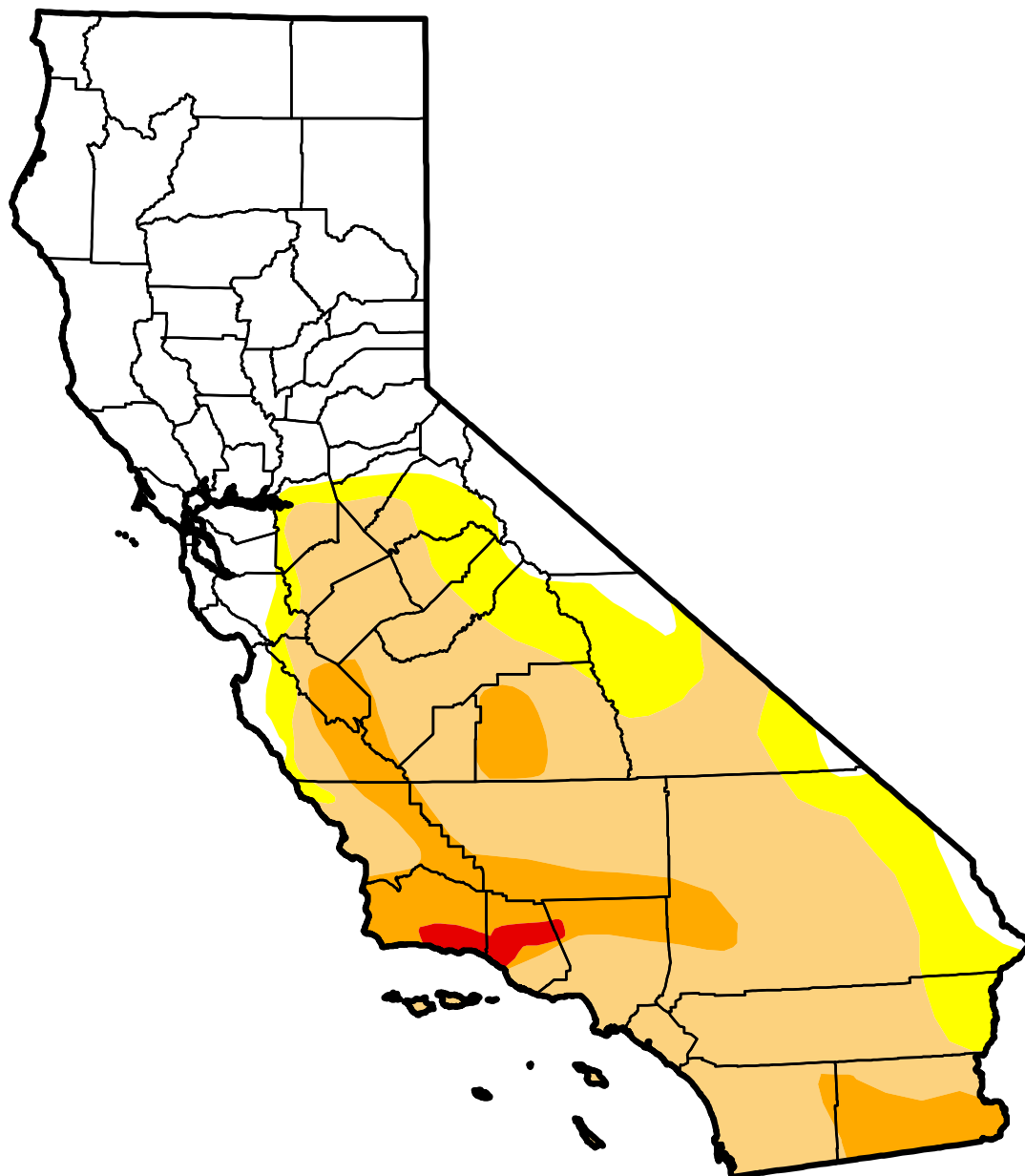
Verdugo Basin Groundwater Elevation

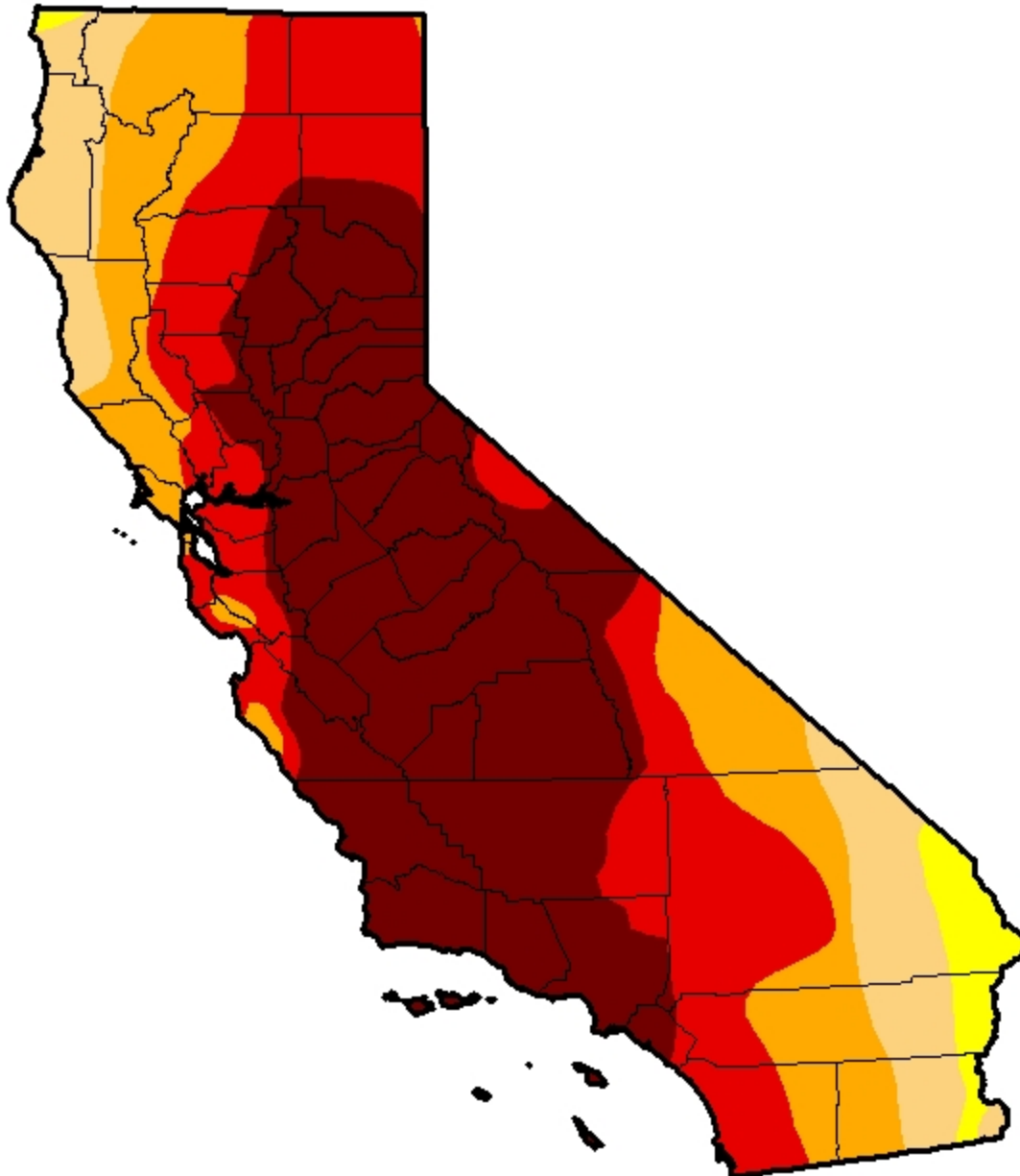

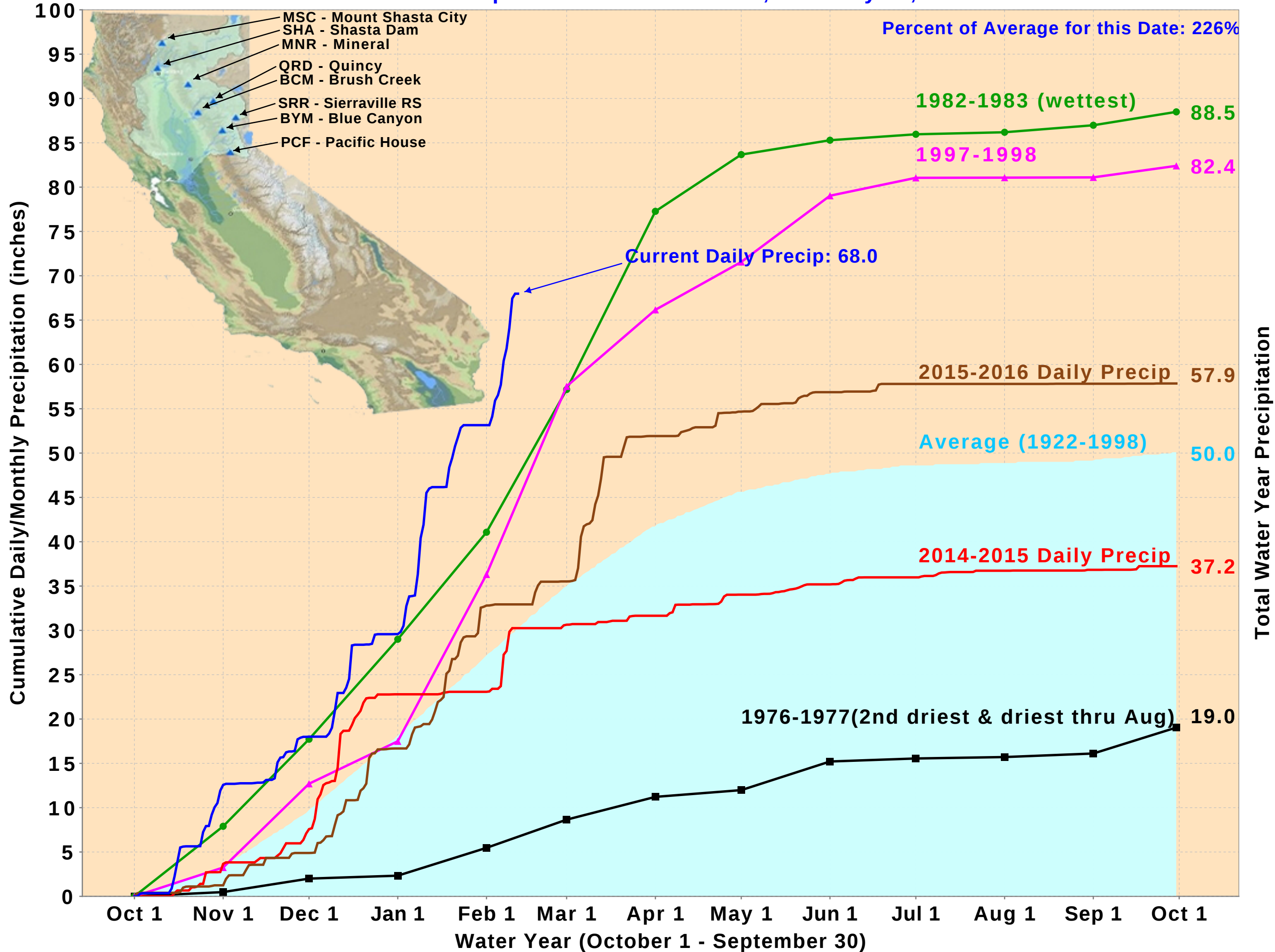
